

CITY PRESENTATION ROLES

Project management handout | 72 points

TEAM GOAL Deliver an engaging 7-minute presentation that uses the model as the primary visual aid and prepares the same three presenters for an 8-minute Q&A.

ROLE	RESPONSIBILITIES
Presenters	Share speaking time, learn the full city, use the model effectively, and deliver with clear, natural, confident communication.
Storytelling Lead	Shape the opening, logical flow, transitions, conclusion, and the reason people want to live in the city.
Script Developers	Write a presentation-specific script that explains the city without simply reading the essay.
Theme Lead	Ensure the presentation clearly explains at least one prevention, one protection, and one recovery solution.
Engineering & Trade-Off Lead	Add engineering roles, technology, EDP, project management, scientific plausibility, risks, benefits, and trade-offs.
Visual Aid Creators	Prepare only allowed, legible aids that enhance the model and fit the official size and budget rules.
Q&A Coach	Run timed mock judging, rotate question types, require complete evidence-based answers, and coach model-based responses.
Rubric Assessors	Review all Content & Delivery and Engineering & Technology criteria and give specific improvement feedback.

Presentation Team Check-In

- ☐ Presentation is 7 minutes or less and leaves enough time for natural pacing.
- ☐ All three official presenters share time and demonstrate comparable knowledge.
- ☐ Model is used throughout to locate and explain solutions.
- ☐ City overview, infrastructure, services, daily life, and innovation are clear.
- ☐ Prevention, protection, and recovery are each explained.
- ☐ EDP, project management, engineering roles, risks, benefits, and trade-offs are covered.
- ☐ Visual aids meet size limits and all materials stay within the combined \$100 budget.
